

# OSITO BABY HAT

## INFANT HAT PATTERN- OSITO

This is a smallish hat, probably suitable for infants 0-6 months, obviously, you can make it bigger by continuing to increase at the point where I've stopped.

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## SUPPLIES

Worsted weight yarn, I used brown cotton, and a size 4.5 mm hook & a locking stitch marker.

## HAT/HEAD

- Round 1 Do not join the rounds, use a stitch marker to mark your rounds, make an adjustable ring and sc 5 around ----- 5 sts.  
Round 2 hdc 2 in each st around ----- 10 sts.  
Round 3 hdc 2 in each st around ----- 20 sts.  
Round 4 [hdc, hdc 2 in next st] 10 times ----- 30 sts.  
Round 5 [2 hdc, hdc 2 in next st] 10 times ----- 40 sts.  
Round 6 [3 hdc, hdc 2 in next st] 10 times ----- 50 sts.  
Rnds 7-20 hdc in each st around ----- 50 sts.  
Finish by slip stitching in each st around to give a more polished edge, fasten off and weave in the remaining yarn.

## EARS (MAKE 2)

- Round 1 make an adjustable ring and sc 5 around ----- 5 sts.  
Round 2 hdc 2 in each st around ----- 10 sts.  
Round 3 hdc 2 in each st around ----- 20 sts.  
Round 4 [hdc, hdc 2 in next st] 10 times ----- 30 sts.  
Rnds 5&6 hdc in each st around ----- 30 sts.  
Round 7 [hdc, hdc2tog] 10 times ----- 20 sts.  
Round 8 [hdc2tog] 10 times ----- 10 sts. Fasten off and using a length of remaining yarn, pinch each ear together and sew the bottoms closed and then sew them to the head wherever you desire ear placement.
